All Gymnasts must be 13 - 15 years old in the year of the event (i.e. born 2004 – 2006).

**MAXIMUM SIZE OF DELEGATION**

- All National Federations are entitled to participate with:
- 1, 2 or 3 Individual Gymnasts
- 1 Group of 5 or 6 Gymnasts

## **COMPETITION FORMAT**

### Individual:

Each Federation has the right to choose the number of exercises to be performed by its registered gymnast(s) for a maximum of 4 routines per Federation (1 routine per apparatus).

To be eligible for the All-Around Ranking, gymnasts must perform all 4 apparatus (Rope, Ball, Clubs, Ribbon).

### Group:

Each Group shall present one exercise with 5 Hoops and one exercise with 5 Ribbons.

## **RANKING**

The Team Ranking is established by adding the 4 scores of the Individual Qualification and the 2 scores of the Group Qualification.

### Individual

The All-Around Ranking is established by adding the results of the 4 Apparatus of the Qualification.

### Group

The All-Around Ranking is established by adding the 2 results of the Qualification.

**SUPERIOR JURY (2)**

All TC members and 7 additional members will form the Superior Juries (SJ), TC President being the President for both Superior Juries. The Superior Juries will be as follows:

**For Panel A and B**

President: TC President

Member (for blocks and inquiries): to be nominated by TC President

**Per Panel:**

Body Difficulty SJ member	2
Apparatus Difficulty SJ member	2
Execution Artistic SJ member	1
Execution Technical SJ member	1

The additional members of the Superior Jury will be nominated by the TC from the pool of judges registered by the participating federations, with the selection criteria determined for the Senior World Championships 2018 and adapted for 2019 (Minimum category 2 with the highest exam results (RGI and RGG) in the selection of the respective function, minimum experience in at least YOG in 2018 or WCH in 2015, WCH in 2017 or WCH 2018 or RIO TEV or RIO OG in 2016 or Commonwealth Games 2018, AND during the present cycle from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018, World Cup or World Challenge Cup. If a Federation rejects the nomination of its judge as SJ no other position will be assigned to any judge from this Federation for this event.

## JUDGES

Each participating Federation must send one RGI and/or one RGG FIG brevetted judge as follows:

- Federations participating with Individual(s) only must register one judge with a valid category of RGI FIG brevet
- Federations participating with a Group only must register one judge with a valid category of RGG FIG brevet
- Federations participating with Individual(s) and a Group must register one judge with a valid category of RGI FIG brevet and a second judge with a valid category of RGG brevet (it can be the same or different judges).

- Budget implications for FIG:
  - Provide Swiss Timing as official scorer
  - Retain all Marketing and TV rights
  - Expenses associated with FIG Staff participating (flight and per diem)
  - Per diem of FIG TC and Jury of Appeal
- Budget implications for 2019 LOC:
  - The LOC will be responsible for all expenses associated with running the event including, but not limited to the cost of the competition & training venues, TV production cost and all local expenses. Host will retain CHF 50 per gymnast for registration fee.
  - Expenses for FIG TD, TC members and 2 Jury of Appeal members participation (flight, housing and local transportation)
  - Local transportation and housing of all FIG staff
- Budget implications for participating Federation:
  - All expenses associated with participation in the event will be at the Federation's expense, including coaches, gymnasts, and a judge per category (D, R, E, T and L judges will be drawn from the pool of judges nominated by participating federations). Members of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Superior Jury will be selected from the pool of judges nominated by participating federations.
